

Hello Refugees. **WE ARE OPEN FOR SERVICE STARTING OCTOBER 4TH!**

Due to Covid-19 there have been some changes that REBC has undergone to ensure your safety upon our reopening and your return.

WHAT WE ARE DOING:

- Streaming of Sunday Service and Wednesday Bible study will now be a mainstay in our ministry.
- We are sanitizing the door handles of the entranceways of the church.
- Temperature checks will take place before service.
- There will now be two services. 10am service will be for our seniors ages 60+. 11:15am will be a general assembly of all ages.
- Chairs in the sanctuary and the lower auditorium will be socially distanced.
- Our Sanctuary capacity has been reduced to comply with City recommendations.
- Sanctuary and the lower auditorium will be disinfected after each service and then each area will be cleaned throughout the week before Sunday service.
- All Bibles and Hymnals have been put away to discourage communal sharing of these items.
- There will be no choir singing.
- Communion will now be done through individual packets.
- Tithes and offerings can still be done online via the church's website or dropped off at the church.

WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU:

- If you are feeling ill, please stay home and enjoy our service via the livestream.
- If you have traveled to a restricted state, please quarantine yourself as per the CDC guidelines. (This will be asked of you upon entering the church.)
- Wear your mask while in the church and maintain social distance.
- Exit the church quickly after service. Fellowship can happen outside.
- Be aware of the instructions of the ushers on how and where to exit the church.
- There is a 2-person maximum in the bathroom at one time.
- There is a 2-person maximum on the elevator at one time.
- Please be on time for service. Seating is limited and will be given on a first come, first serve basis.
